Play Session Every Wednesday

Lipe Tennis Academy—at EHS.

The LTA is for competitive tennis players ages 8-18. Players enrolled in this program are *expected to play tournaments regularly*; participants usually have USTA District and possibly Sectional rankings. High school players wishing to participate in this class must be varsity players only. The comprehensive training includes play sessions, drills, videotaping analysis, mental training, goal setting, strength and plyometrics.

LTA First Day Tournament: Tuesday, June 9, 2009

Classes will be divided by skill level with the top 24 players playing in **Group 1, 8:00-10:30 a.m.; Group 2, 11:00-1:30; Group 3 2:00-4:30 (for kids with summer school!)**. Players will be placed in groups per the results of each LTA Tournament. Athletes not attending the tournaments will be placed in groups at staff discretion. The LTA Tournament will begin at 8:30 a.m. and conclude around 2:30 (a phone will be available with which to call rides); players should bring lunch or \$5 for a brought-in meal, which includes a “sub” sandwich, chips and drink. *Parents are discouraged from attending the LTA Tournaments to encourage players’ self-sufficiency.* Alternate sites may be used to accommodate the size of the tournament.

All New for 2009—Wednesday Play Sessions at Liberty MS. All players will be organized into monitored, coached, weekly play sessions that will be played every Wednesday. Play sessions will be organized by performance level. **Session I: Top 16 at 8 a.m. Session II: Next 16 at 10:00 a.m. Session III: Next 16, and kids who do Group 3 due to a summer school conflict will play at 2:00.** All play sessions will last approximately 2 hours. Because the kids will be playing actual matches, some may occasionally finish slightly later or earlier. Kids who finish early will be encouraged to stay and hit. Coaches will provide detailed feedback at the conclusion of each play session. Play session results will be used to organize the training sessions. Kids will be notified in writing at the end of the First Day Tournament as to which play session they should come. All matches will be recorded, and the kids will play singles and doubles.

Cost: This year to accommodate busy schedules, you may choose exactly the number of weeks you wish to join. See opposite side for weeks and prices. **(8 weeks is only \$36 per week, or just over \$5 per hour!)**

Private Lessons: All LTA tennis professionals are available for private or semi-private lessons. Private lessons are recommended for all players and must be arranged by patrons with the pro of their choice; see lipetennis.com for brief bios and contact information. Rates vary and are conducted at a location arranged by the professional and client.

Rain Out Policy: Four rainout dates are scheduled per class. Dates missed due to bad weather exceeding these cannot be made up. Makeup times and dates will be announced. However, students may arrange to make up classes in a subsequent session if space is available. Please see any coach to arrange this. The decision to cancel class due to weather will be made one hour before class starts when possible. The staff then tries to quickly notify families by telephone. If classes are rained out in-progress, students will be in the building by the courts or under the pavilion.
